Notice to all members, Madison Division Wisconsin Chapter NECA.

The Madison Division Labor Management Committee recently agreed to the following changes to IBEW Local Union #159 administrative referral rules. **Paragraph #7** will be amended to read as follows:

All respondents will be ranked according to their referral position. The Union will create a list of successful bidders and immediately share said list with the requesting Employer. The successful applicants will be notified by phone by 9:00 a.m. the day following the Employer request for manpower of their status. At this time, the Union will provide a contact phone number and a contact person of the Employer to whom the respondent has been assigned. It is the responsibility of the respondent to contact the designated Employer representative no later than 10:00 a.m. to receive directions regarding specific job requirements including where and when to report. Failure to make this contact will result in the respondent being ineligible for the referral and a strike being assigned to the respondent.

This change goes into effect on **June 1, 2017**. After this date, the local union referral agent will provide a list of individuals being referred to an employer after a manpower request has been made. The applicants will be given the employer's contact name and number to call for instructions. At this time, the employer can provide the instructions or decline to offer the individual employment.
